The Community Engagement for Health Equity in COVID-19 Prevention and Mitigation Project will develop and expand education, communication, training, and outreach strategies to help address health disparities and create greater equity in access to and delivery of COVID-19 prevention and mitigation activities.

Grant Objectives

1. Reduce COVID-19 -related health disparities.
2. Increased access to COVID-19 vaccine among higher risk and underserved populations, defined as Native Hawaiians, other Pacific Islanders, Filipinos, and other populations based on COVID-19 data and projected trends (“High Risk/Underserved Populations”)
3. Increased COVID-19 vaccination rates, testing, and uptake of mitigation measures among High Risk/Underserved Populations.
4. Improved community capacity to prevent and control COVID-19 infection and transmission among High Risk/Underserved Populations.
5. Increased community and cross-sectoral partnerships with capacity to address COVID-19 health disparities.
6. Increased capacity of Community-Based Organizations (CBO) to deliver culturally and linguistically tailored public health education, communication, and training to the targeted populations, primarily High Risk/Underserved Populations.
7. Improved and expanded community education, communication and messaging, and training around COVID-19 vaccination and other vaccine preventable diseases (e.g., influenza).

Performance Measures

Community-Based Organizations are required to report all activities on an ongoing basis.

- Identify and prioritize disproportionately affected populations for vaccination
- Promote vaccine awareness and uptake
- Successes and challenges of reaching high risk/underserved populations
- Successes and challenges in supporting community engagement
- Vaccine services available to CBO or local partners
- Partnered community organizations that promote vaccine awareness and uptake

COVID-19 Registration

- Simplified COVID-19 vaccine registration processes (challenges/successes)
- Existing non-digital options for COVID-19 registration

- List of trusted messengers that developed messaging campaigns, engage communities, and build vaccine confidence
